

IS BLOOD REALLY BLUE OF RED? By: Hailey Botelho

What do you think? Would you believe me if I told you that blood is, in fact blue without it hitting oxygen? As we all know when we go for blood work we see red blood. So your brain assumes that blood is red. Why wouldn't you? But you cannot always believe what you see. Blood only appears red because when blood hits oxygen, a chemical reaction occurs which makes this sticky substance turn the color you see.

Now, have you ever gone and asked a doctor that works in this type of business? I know I have. There's only one response that you should get when you ask this question, "So is blood really blue or red inside your veins before it hits air?" The correct response for this is "blue." The blood around our lungs are somewhat dark red. Not saying that this is the true color because its not, but this is only true because we use our lungs to breath. We also have oxygen in our body. This will mean that oxygen-filled blood is a form of red. But, if the blood is filled with oxygen than it is not the true color blood. The oxygen changes the color. This is what everyone gets confused about. On the web we get results about the blood near our lungs after you breath. So you don't get the true color of blood that has 0% oxygen.

Everyone loves the internet, so I decided to look in it a little further. It took some time to get all the right information and now I have proof that the true color of blood is really blue. What would be a better way to show this than real life examples!

"Once you die, the heart isn't working to move the blood around anymore, and you're not drawing in any oxygen. But if someone cuts a dead man's hand off, the blood will be red from reacting with the air. "Red" blood cells only look red when they have oxygen. Without any, they're a dark purple. Because it runs out of oxygen, which reacts with the hemoglobin in your blood, it makes it red. That's why the veins going up your wrist toward your heart are blue even when you're alive. They're out of oxygen. You can bleed from anywhere and it will come out red because it's reacting with the oxygen in the air." - Courtney Schumacher, been teaching biology for 35+ years

Q. How does the oxygen convert the color of blood into bright red?

- A. The coloring matter of the blood is formed by very minute globules floating in it; the oxygen makes them milky and the dark coloring matter of the blood seen through this milky coat appears of a bright red.
- Q. How does the oxygen we inhale mingle with the blood?
 - A. The oxygen of the air mingles with the blood in the lungs, and converts it into a bright red color.
- Q. What color is blood before it is oxidized in the lungs?
 - A. A dark purple. The oxygen turns it to a bright red. " A Guide To The Scientific Knowledge Of Things Familiar

"Hemoglobin contains iron. The iron reacts with oxygen, giving blood its red color." - Medical News Today

These show that when we die, our blood turns blue. If our blood turns blue when we die because of the no oxygen being inhaled, than that means, that bloods true color deoxygenated is **<u>BLUE</u>**.


HOW TO HELP ANIMALS IN POUNDS OF SHELTERS By: Ava Richmond







